

### **CONCEPT AND GUIDELINES:**

Great men from various walks of life (thinkers, reformers, cultural mascots, artists, writers, national leaders) have conceived and perceived the India of My dreams in a particular manner. Such visions are not born in abstraction. They need to be contextualised in the time in which they were carved and spelt.

Itihās Darpan, The Department of History Sri Aurobindo College (Eve) invites students to share analyse and contextualise the views of well known personalities from India between the period 1890s and 1960s who used their experiential knowledge creative impulse, and professional skills to outline the vision of India of My dreams. In order to participate in this inter-college paper reading compètition, the student will have to submit an abstract of 600 words. Abstract including paper presentation can be done either in English or in Hindi. The last date for submission of abstract is 8th October. Selected abstracts can be converted into a paper for paper reading competition which will be held in the month of October. Guidelines will be sent for the presentation if the paper is selected. Apart from attractive prizes, participation certificate will be given to each participant

The team will review the abstracts; each student will be notified whether or not their abstract has been selected. Papers are to be submitted only if the abstract is selected. The papers must be formatted with all sources cited in accordance with the 9th edition of the MLA handbook or Chicago style. All submissions should be in Times New Roman font, size 12, and in PDF format. Guidelines will be sent for the presentation if the paper is selected.

The abstract must be original. If there are any direct quotes, credit is to be given to the author/speaker, and/or the source is to be cited.
