About the College

Sri Aurobindo College (Evening), named after the legendary philosopher, nationalist and reformer Sri Aurobindo Ghose, was established in 1984, as a constituent College of the University of Delhi. The college is a NAAC accredited Grade B+ institution. It has also been placed amongst the top 150 Higher Education Institutions by the National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) of the Ministry for Human Resource Development.

In the year 1988 this Evening College made history by opening its doors to women students. The College had begun by offering instructions in B.A. (Prog.) and B.Com. (Prog.) Courses. Over the years courses in B.Com. (Honours), B.A. (Honours) Hindi and B.A. (Honours) Applied Psychology were introduced. The College presently offers the following courses in 1st. year: B.Com. (Hons.), B.Com., B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology, B.A. (Hons.) Hindi, B.A. (Prog.), B.A (hons.) English and B.A (Hons) Economics.

The way we used to teach students and prepare them for the world has changed drastically over the last few years, and collegiate teaching can be viewed as a dynamic process demanding teachers and institutions to be more in the role of mentors and innovators. We at Sri Aurobindo College (Evening) have overhauled our pedagogical apparatus and infrastructure to equip our students better. ANNUAL REPORT OF THE LIBRARY: 2022-2023

The College library is committed to excellence through an innovative information service and support to the Faculty members and the Students in their information needs.

The College library is well-equipped, and its collection consists of more than 46500 volumes of books. More than 1500 volumes of books were added during this financial year 2022-2023 in all relevant subjects and all ICT facilities. The library has a rich Reference Section consisting of Reference books, Encyclopedias, Classic collection of Literature and Dictionaries etc. The library also subscribes to a many magazines, newspapers, printed Journals and E- Journals and E-books (N-LIST E-Resources). The library is using Cloud based software, E-Granthalaya 4.0 software, which is developed by NIC.

Key Facility of the Library:

- To provide facility of various relevant printed and e-resources to the Faculty members, Non-Teaching staff and the Students.
- To provide a remote Access facility of N-LIST E-Resources to the Faculty members and students.
- To provide 08 computer systems in the library to access the Internet and various E-Resources.
- To provide computerized library services to the users with the help of integrated library software and also provide Mobile Apps based Web OPAC, SMS and Email facility for the Library Users.

Remote Access to N-LIST E-Resources: The College library is also a member of N-LIST (INFILIBNET) E-Resources . Member ID login for the students and Faculty members have been created to provide remote login access facility of N-LIST e-resources.

Departmental Reports

Department of Applied Psychology

Following academic activities were carried out during academic session, 2022-2023

- “Alvida”- The Farewell party

On May 9, 2022, the students of II and IV-semester of B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology arranged a memorable farewell party to the final year outgoing students. The Principal and the teachers of department conveyed their best wishes to the outgoing batch. Various interesting activities, games, singing and dance performances were part of the event. The day ended by capturing memories with photo sessions.

- Interactive session on “Stress and Management Techniques”

An Interactive session on “Stress and Management Techniques” by Dr. M.L. Zou, Trainer, North Eastern Police Academy was held on September 12, 2022. The purpose of the seminar was to educate the students on the coping techniques for dealing with stress in day-to-day life. The informative session included the positive and negative effects of stress and how humans prefer a constant homeostasis state.

- An international workshop on “Relationship between time perspective and stress”

An international workshop was conducted on September 14, 2022 by two learned specialists from the field of Psychology: Prof. Lening A. Olivera-Figueroa, Department of Psychiatry, School of Medicine, Yale university, USA and Dr. Dinesh Chhabra, Associate Professor, Department of Psychology, University of Delhi. Dr.Lening A Olivera Figueroa explained and led presentation based on his research on Time Perspective and Acculturative Stress on Adaptive and Maladaptive the Strategies. Dr. Chhabra talked about the importance of Psychological First Aid (PFA), a mental health analogue to physical first aid and is applicable to ourselves, our friends, family and co-workers.

- Eunoia’22-Mental Health Awareness Week Celebration

On the occasion of Mental health Awareness week, “Eunoia”- a three-day exhilarating event was organised from 10th-12th October’22. Each day included various engaging activities, insightful seminars by Dr. Arvind Mishra, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi on "Globalization and its discontents: challenges of mental health in contemporary times"; and a presentation by Deepshikha Goswami, the CEO of Sukoon Ghar organization on Relationships;

seminar by Ms Kaustubhi Shukla, Clinical psychologist on anxiety from the Indian perspective. Soul on the beats: Dance movement therapy; and an Interactive session by Mentify foundation on self-awareness and Emotional intelligence; Workshop: Letting go by Manraahi; Art of Mind control and Spiritual Healing by ISKCON temple; Dear Diary: Article Presentation; and Mano dhrithi: Mental Health Skit by Rangmanch.

- Workshop on “Indian Psychology”

A workshop on Indian Psychology on December 1, 2022 was conducted by a research scholar Mr. Amit Prakash, DU on ‘Indian Psychological Thought and Traditions: Concepts and Perspectives.’ The workshop was an enriching experience for all the students.

- Seminar on “Hypnosis and Past Life Regression”

A seminar was conducted by Dr.Navneeth Vallabh, President of the Rotary Club Delhi and Director at NVFP Pvt Ltd - media company on January 16, 2023 on “Hypnosis and Past Life Regression”. Dr. Vallabh commenced the session with insights on the psychoanalytical theories and structure of human mind. It was quite an effective seminar with practical

demonstration that helped the students discover an arena which was out of their regular syllabi.

- “Mental Health Examination”- An invited lecture

On January 30, 2023, a lecture on Mental Status Examination and Case Study was delivered by Prof. Dinesh Tyagi, Head, Dept. of Psychiatry, Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar College, Delhi. He put an insight on MSE as an important tool for neurological and psychiatric evaluations. Emphasis was put on how MSE provides important information for diagnosis and assessment of disorder's course and response for treatment.

- “Psybies”-Freshers’ Party

The psychological society organized a Freshers’ Party “Psybies” on February 3, 2023 to welcome the batch of 2022. The program started with lamp lightening and followed by Sarasvati Vandana. Principal and head of the department addressed the gathering with their words of wisdom. Fresher were welcomed by red roses and were invited to showcase their talents. The event concluded with a choir group and DJ which was enjoyed by every student.

- “Conflict Resolution”-An Interactive Session

On February 6, 2023, an interactive session was conducted on “conflict resolution” by Mr. Chhabi Adhikari (NLP Expert/Life Coach), a renowned expert from Nepal. The speaker provided insights into the nature of conflict, the reasons for conflicts and effective strategies for resolving them like active listening, empathy, and collaborative problem solving.

Department of Economics

- On September 28, 2022, Eco Shastra conducted a debate competition on “Privatization is the Path to Economic Development” in the College Seminar room. The competition started with the opening remarks of the Principal. The participants put forth their views for or against the statement. After an energetic discussion, results were announced. It ended with the concluding remarks of our TIC, in which he talked about Joseph Stiglitz, the pioneer of Privatisation, who, after seeing its effects, made remarks against it.
- A quiz competition was organized by Eco Shastra on September 29, 2022, in the College Computer lab. Participants were quizzed on current socio-economic issues as well as conceptual issues of Micro and Macro Economics. It was followed by the announcement of result and prize distribution.

Department of Sanskrit

This program was organized on the occasion of Gita Jayanti, which is celebrated as the day when Bhagvad Gita, the sacred text of the Hindus, was composed. Srimad Bhagwad Gita has been the philosophical and spiritual guide of every Hindu since time immemorial. In Bhagwad Gita, Lord Krishna explained every aspect of the universe and milky way to his friend Arjuna, which is considered as the eternal wisdom even in modern time. The Bhagwad Gita is the sole source of solution to every worldly problem and it gives real meaning to human life in real sense. This program was organized via virtual platform. Enactus

The Enactus chapter of Sri Aurobindo College (Eve.) was formed in 2016 and is one of the most active student organizations on the south campus, University of Delhi. The projects help to give real life experience and exposure of all facets of social entrepreneurship and management to its members, including increasing financial and entrepreneurial literacy.

The basic aim of PROJECT ANNAPOORNA is Women Empowerment through Social Entrepreneurship, and it has enabled homemakers, to establish a tiffin service business. The student team act as management consultants and have provided the necessary ecosystem for enabling a domestic activity to take the form of a flourishing business. The Society has honed the business skills of these homemakers and has thus not only helped to make them self-reliant and financially empowered, but is also instrumental in improving the financial condition of their families.

PROJECT ISHTA - ‘Initiative for Sanitation and Hygiene Towards All’ – a project on woman entrepreneurship for hygienic sanitation. Project ISHTA is aimed at enabling complete, inexpensive public hygiene for women. We have created a convenient, hygienic and waterproof toilet seat cover which fits all seats and gives complete coverage and protection. The project complements the government’s vision of “SWACHH BHARAT” as the proceeds from our toilet seat covers are used for the construction of public toilets in underserved regions. Clean is also green. ISHTA is minimalistic and follows 3 R’s- ‘Reduce’ the use of paper, ‘Redeploy’ proceeds for sanitation, and use ‘Recyclable’ material for safe disposal.

Project Katran aims to reduce waste in the fashion industry by utilizing scrap cloth materials that are discarded by factories and tailoring shops. It is based on principles of recycling and upcycling and helps to reduce and recycle waste and create employment opportunities for women.

Enactus students have participated enthusiastically in different events throughout the year. Project Annapoorna won the second prize at *Projectus 22*, a B-Plan Competition organised by Swami Shraddhanand College. Students also participated in the shark tank event at *GNOSIS* organised by Akhilesh Das Gupta Institute of Technology & Management.
