Departmental Reports

Department of Applied Psychology

The Department of Applied Psychology organised "Izhaar'24" on February 20, 2024 to promote emotional health among students. The event featured interactive stalls for emotional expression and introspection. Activities like "Energy Takers Energy Givers," "Feeling Dicey," and "Paint Your Soul" allowed creative expression. The Principal, Prof. Arun Chaudhary, graced the event, fostering a positive environment for personal growth. Students were encouraged to develop effective strategies for managing their emotions.

The Psychological Society of the Applied Psychology department, Psyght, organised a "Charcha Express" – a discussion session on February 20, 2024, on the topic "Gender Biases in Emotional Well Being". Moderators facilitated an insightful conversation that addressed societal biases and explored strategies to overcome them. The session provided valuable insights into societal challenges and fostered critical thinking skills among 31 students.

The Department hosted a panel discussion titled "Alumni Speaks on Career Choices and Future in Psychology Worldwide" on February 29, 2024, welcoming speakers Shiv Kumar Shukla, Madhur Upadhyay, and Navneeth Vallabh. The event highlighted diverse career opportunities in psychology and prospects in the field, providing students with valuable insights and guidance. One hundred three participants, including faculty and students, attended the discussion.

A Clinical Psychology Seminar on "Mental Status Examination and Case Study in Clinical Settings" was held on April 2, 2024, with 42 participants in attendance. Dr. Manoj Kumar, an Associate Professor from the Department of Psychology at the University of Delhi, was the guest speaker. Dr. Kumar's lecture was engaging and informative, emphasising the importance of confidentiality and privacy in clinical practice.

A special talk and an interactive session were organised on 9th April 2024, in which Mr Puneet Kumar, Author, Corporate Trainer, Relationship and NLP Coach, was the Keynote Speaker. The interactive session primarily focused on developing professional and personal skills for effective relationship management in organisational settings.

A workshop titled "Understanding Dementia: Assessment and Management" was organised on April 10, 2024. Ms Soni Jaiswal, Assistant Professor at Gargi College, conducted the workshop, which provided an overview of the signs and symptoms of dementia and critical strategies for psychology professionals.

The Department organised an experiential exercise on "Clinical Hypnotherapy: Career and Prospects" on April 10, 2024, in which Mr Navneeth Vallabh, a Renowned Clinical Hypnotherapist, past-life Regression Therapist, and psychologist, was the special speaker. The speaker discussed with the students the overview of clinical hypnotherapy as a career and its application in various therapeutic contexts.

The department launched a "Comprehensive Course Coverage and Revision Program" for CUET Post-Graduate and Other Entrance Examinations. Faculty members conducted free extra classes, with a condensed approach, to cover and revise the entire syllabus for BA (Hons.) Applied Psychology - VI Semester students.

Two of our students, Shankar Tripathi and Lakshika Juggal of BA. (Hons.) VI Semester had their research papers published in reputed international journals under the tutelage and mentorship of Professor Pragyendu. Three final-year students of BA (Hons.), Bheeni Gupta (21/3081), Kritika Joshi (21/3094), and Sadhvi Sharma (21/3059) of the Department, have qualified for GATE (Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering) 2024. Shriyanshi Gupta, B.A. (Hons) Applied Psychology, secured 1st position in the Sargan (Solo Song) Competition at "Spandan 2024," organised by the New Delhi Institute of Management. Pareena Dutt (Roll No.- 21/3077), a final-year student of BA (Hons.) Applied Psychology has been offered admission to King's College, London, United Kingdom, in the Mental Health Studies M.Sc. (Full-time) Course.

"Nidaan" is an initiative launched by the department with the support of Psyght to address the mental health needs of students and nearby communities in South Delhi. The counselling sessions are conducted one-on-one by a team of dedicated volunteers who are available 24/7.

From January 10, 2024, the department provided an exceptional two-week internship opportunity to final-year students in the Department of Psychiatry at Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar Hospital & Medical College, Sec-6, Rohini, New Delhi. Students gained hands-on clinical experience to supplement their theoretical knowledge, which is essential for their growth as mental health professionals. The collaboration allowed students to observe clinical cases and learn from experienced professionals, resulting in mutual benefits.

The department organised a two-day fest, " Psychedelia “, on April 24 and 25, 2024. This event's major theme was “the art of self-discovery and healing.” Prof. Roshan Lal, Department of Psychology, University of Delhi, delivered the keynote address. Many prominent speakers, such as Prof. Dinesh Chhabra and Prof. Surender Kumar Sia of Delhi University, were invited to this event.

Department of Commerce

The Department of Commerce organised a participative and interactive workshop on “Understanding Marketing” on November 30, 2023. The speaker, Mr. Amandeep Singh Sodhi, Executive Director of DSM, a marketing organisation based in Mohali, with nine years of experience working on projects in collaboration with the Confederation of Indian Industry, shared valuable insights with the students.

In March 2024, the Department organised an inter-college event called COMMVERVE. The event included a Pitch Desk Competition where participants presented novel business proposals and pitched for funding from investors. The competition consisted of three rounds, with the first two being simulated elimination rounds held on March 5 and 6, 2024. The final round occurred on the college premises on March 7, 2024, and the winning teams received cash prizes. This competition provided students with an opportunity to assess business acumen and financial requirements for launching a successful startup.

The Finance and Investment Cell of the Department organised an Inter-College Competition called Trading Titans: A Mock Stock Competition. This event provided students with a practical learning experience, allowing them to experience the challenges of buying and selling stocks online without using real money. The event concluded in the final round on March 7, 2024, after two elimination rounds held earlier. It was a testament to our commitment to providing hands-on learning opportunities. The winning teams claimed cash prizes, further boosting their confidence in their financial skills.

An interactive workshop on financial empowerment was conducted on March 7, 2024. Mr. Taresh Bhatia, the speaker, discussed how to plan and evaluate investment avenues for small and large investors and build a corpus over time in a planned way. The students showed keen interest in the subject by asking relevant real-life questions. The event concluded with our principal, Professor Arun Chaudhary, delivering an inspiring speech and distributing certificates and coupons from various sponsors to the winners.

Department of Economics

Ecoshastra, the Economics Society, successfully organised an Inter-College debate competition titled "D'economia 2.0" in the Seminar Hall on 31 October 2023. Esteemed chief guest Dr Vipin Aggarwal addressed the event. The topic of the debate was "How Does the Government's Economic Policies Impact Social Welfare?". Around 120 students from various colleges registered for the event. The event provided a platform for a healthy and informative exchange of ideas, enabling students to delve deeper into the complexities of economic policies and their impact on social welfare.

The Inter-College Quiz Contest "Econtrivia" was organised on 21st February 2024 in the Seminar Hall. More than 20 teams registered from various colleges, and eight teams participated in the final event. Teams ARTHYA (SACE), AR (SACE), and RAYS (Shaheed Bhagat Singh College) secured the first, second, and third positions, respectively. Prof. Arun Chaudhary, Principal of Sri Aurobindo College (Evening), distributed the winning prizes and gave an inspiring speech to the students.

Department of English

The Department of English organised an orientation programme for first-year BA (H) English and English discipline students on 16 August 2023. Students were welcomed to the college and enlightened about the structure of their courses under the UGCF (NEP 2022). The teacher-in-charge of the English Department, Dr Rajni Kant Goswami, briefed the students about the significance of elective papers such as Generic Electives, SEC, and VAC papers.

An event titled 'Adieu' was held on 29 September 2023 in honour of Dr Kanchan Mohindra and to convey good wishes on her farewell. Faculty members and the students expressed their heartfelt gratitude to Dr. Mohindra and conveyed best wishes for her retired life.

On November 23, 2023, the department warmly welcomed newly appointed teachers. The new faculty members were given an overview of the courses offered during the current Academic Session of 2023-24.

On February 20, 2024, the English literary society "Musings" organised a "Story Writing and Poetry Composition Competition" to encourage students to express their creativity and hone their writing skills. The event aimed to provide an outlet for students to express their perspectives through the power of words. The competition included Short Story and Poetry Composition categories and saw a great turnout of enthusiastic student participants. The prize-winning entries are published in the College magazine 'Aditi'.

Department of Environmental Studies

The department focused on different environmental issues and organised various educational and awareness programmes under the aegis of IQAC. On World Ozone Day (16 September 2023), students were sensitised about the issues related to ozone layer depletion. Posters addressing various issues related to ozone layer depletion helped students raise awareness about the issue.

Wildlife Week was observed from 2nd to 8th October 2023, during which students were sensitised about the issues related to Wildlife conservation. Students raised awareness about wildlife with the help of posters focusing on different topics related to wildlife conservation.

World Wetlands Day is celebrated on February 2 each year to increase awareness about the importance of wetlands. The Department of Environmental Science organised a poster-making competition on "Wetlands and Human Wellbeing" on this day in 2024, wherein 74 students participated. The department also held a lecture on Wetland conservation, where students were informed about the importance of wetlands and the factors that can harm their functioning. The lecture also covered wetlands' economic and recreational values, using practical evidence from local wetlands.

On 4th April 2024, the Department of Environmental Science and Eco Club organised a nature walk at Neela Hauz Biodiversity Park and Sanjay Van in New Delhi. Thirty-five students and faculty members participated in the walk to learn about a natural wetland ecosystem, wastewater treatment, and the importance of biological heritage. The mini biodiversity park spreads over 10 acres near Sanjay Van, Vasant Kunj. Dr Dinesh Albertson, a field biologist from Aravalli Biodiversity Park, explained the process of treating domestic wastewater at Neela Hauz Biodiversity Park through natural filtration without any chemical treatment. Mr Narendra Singh, an attendant at Neela Hauz Biodiversity Park, helped the students better understand the park. Students learned about wild species of grasses and shrubs that can turn drainage wastewater into fresh water.

Department of Hindi

Department of Sanskrit

On the same day, the Devvani Society of the Sanskrit department organised a Freshers’ Welcome Ceremony for the newly inducted students. The College Principal, Prof. Vipin Kumar Agrawal, addressed the students about the importance of the Sanskrit language.

An essay writing competition on “Gandhiji's teachings and moral values” was held on 30 January 2023. Forty students actively participated in the competition, which was organised on Gandhiji's 76th Martyrdom Day. Certificates were given to all the participants.

Gender Sensitization Committee

National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)

Placement, Internship and Training Cell (PITC)

INSPIRUS 3.0: Journey from Academia to Workforce

The Placement, Internship and Training Cell (PITC) organised various programmes to create awareness about the opportunities available to students. Inspirus, the flagship event of PITC, is organised annually for the benefit of students across University of Delhi. The events undertaken in the 2023-24 session are as follows:

Seminar: The PITC invited Dr. Sayantan Kundu, Assistant Professor (Finance), Indian Management Institute, Kolkata, as an expert on 'Financial Modelling' for an interactive session with the students to discuss career opportunities in the field of finance. The seminar proved to be extremely useful as it provided insights into the volatile behaviour of the stock market and shed light on the risks involved while investing in the stock market. The seminar also discussed the options to minimise risks by investors.

Innovative hybrid internship, training and job fair with the objective to bring together proficient internship/job seekers and employers from across India.

A number of activities marked the week-long Inspirus 3.0 event under the title 'Learnathon'. The programme started with a seminar on 'CV Building' by Raghav Mutneja. Campus recruitment drives were held during the event and Group Discussion and Personal Interviews (GD-PI) were held by Ernst and Young (EY). Ms Jasneer Bhalla, the resource person for the virtual Webinar on 'Campus to Corporate' motivated students to plan career strategies towards achieving immense growth. The internship and recruitment drives were organised and conducted alongside the aforementioned activities on all days of the programme. While preparing for the programme, the PITC conducted a total of 29 pre-recruitment and pre-internship drives throughout the year with a total of 350-400 registrations. 18 offer letters have been received for internships. This number is likely to go up before the end of the semester. 18 MoUs have been signed by the college, thus far. 23 students out of 145 registered participants have been successfully shortlisted for the recruitment drive.

Project X-Culture

Project X-Culture is a large-scale experiential learning collaborative exercise initiated by the University of North Carolina, USA. Since 2013, students from Sri Aurobindo College (Evening) have been selected for the project under the mentorship of Prof Sumati Varma.
